SCHOOL BUS ROUTING AND SCHEDULING

Reference Code: EEAB

The location and scheduling of school bus routes and the location of bus stops shall be determined by the Superintendent or his/her designee. Bus stops shall be established in such a way as to provide for safe and efficient transportation.

The Board believes that it is reasonable to expect students to walk up to one-half mile to reach a desirable pick-up point for regular transportation. The riding time of any student shall not exceed one hour.

School bus transportation shall be limited to transporting the student from his/her home to school and from school back to his/her home. A student who is eligible for regular transportation may be transported to or from a babysitter's home provided the babysitter's home is on an established route.

Summer School Transportation

The Board, in order to provide reasonable summer school transportation services, shall establish bus stops in Helenville, Rome, Sullivan and along the established routes. Eligible students may utilize any of the established bus stops. If a student's home is not an established bus stop, a letter from the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) authorizing the district to allow his/her/their child to use one of the established bus stops shall be required.
