## STUDENT MEMBERSHIP ACCOUNTING

Students in the School District of Jefferson shall be considered full time if they can be classified into at least one of the following categories:

- 1. A 5-K kindergarten student who attends school full days in accordance with Board policy establishing the normal school day for elementary school students.
- 2. An elementary school student who attends school full days in accordance with Board policy establishing the normal school day for elementary school students.
- 3. A middle school student who attends school full days in accordance with Board policy establishing the normal school day for middle school students.
- 4. A high school student who attends school full days in accordance with Board policy establishing the normal school day for high school students.
- 5. A student classified as having a disability and scheduled in accordance with the individualized education program (IEP) and approved by the Director of Pupil Services.
- 6. A student who has completed four full years of high school and is returning to pick up additional credits for high school graduation.
- 7. A student on a partial schedule due to a medical- or health-related disability.
- 8. A student receiving homebound instruction or a special program as approved by the student's parent/guardian and school officials (i.e., children at risk program, school-age parent program).
- 9. A district resident attending a school in another public school district on a full-time basis under the state's public school open enrollment program.

A 4-K kindergarten student enrolled in the K-4 Jefferson Kids program shall be considered 0.6 FTE for membership count purposes.

A student enrolled in the district's Early Childhood (EC) program shall be considered 0.5 FTE for membership count purposes.
