Jefferson High School Basic Supply list







The high school does **not** have a set supply list because students choose a variety of classes. The items on the list below are **not** required but can be used as a general idea of the basic items high school students use. In general, we tell students to look at their schedule and have a notebook and folder for each class along with pens and pencils to start out. If they are enrolled in a class that requires a certain item (like a calculator or binder) their teachers will let them know during the first week of school.

The Basics

- No. 2 pencils
- Colored pencils
- Large pink eraser
- Ballpoint pens
- Spiral-bound or composition notebooks
- Loose-leaf notebook paper (most teachers ask that students use the college-ruled variety.)
- Ruler with English and metric measurements
- Headphones

*Please note- Students are not allowed to carry backpacks. They may be kept in lockers during the day.

- Several three-ring binders (Some teachers require that a binder be used exclusively for their class.)
- Pocket folders that fit in binders
- Pencil case
