

STUDENT EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Extracurricular activities, both noncompetitive and competitive, are considered to be a vital part of the total instructional program for the students of the School District of Jefferson.

Noncompetitive activities include such activities as language clubs, subject interest clubs and intramural sports. The emphasis in noncompetitive activities at all grade levels shall be participation. Competitive activities include, but are not limited to, interscholastic athletics, forensics and academic competition. Competitive, in this context, refers to the manner in which students are selected to participate.

Students in grades kindergarten through eight shall have the opportunity to participate in any extracurricular activity offered at their grade level. The Board of Education encourages full participation by all such students in these activities. All students in grades nine through 12 shall have the opportunity to participate in any noncompetitive activity offered at the high school and to be considered for participation in any competitive activity offered at the high school.

Students must adhere to all rules and regulations established for participation in each extracurricular activity. Students who violate school and/or activity rules or regulations shall be subject to disciplinary action.

The School District of Jefferson shall not discriminate in admission to any program or activity, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions or facilities usage on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. All educational facilities in the district shall be equally available to all students according to the same criteria, under the same conditions and during comparable time intervals. This shall include separate and comparable locker rooms, shower and rest facilities for boys and girls. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
