

STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

Students in the School District of Jefferson shall be provided with information on available academic scholarships.

A list of available local scholarships shall be distributed to the senior class. The high school counseling department shall maintain records of available local, state and/or national scholarships.

The School District of Jefferson shall not discriminate in acceptance and administration of gifts, bequests, scholarships and other aids on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.

STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS GUIDELINES

The High School Counseling Office will send a letter to individuals and groups who sponsor scholarships each October asking if there are any changes in their scholarship procedures/applications. Changes are due to the Counseling Office by December 1 of each school year. The Counseling Office will create a scholarship booklet for student distribution by December 15 of each school year.

Students who would like to access scholarship information prior to December 15 may go online and retrieve the information from the previous school year. However, there is always the possibility that a scholarship sponsor may change their procedures and/or application and the student may have to complete a new application.
