

## **CHROMEBOOK LOGIN DIRECTIONS AND DIRECTIONS OR NAVIGATION** **INSTRUCTIONS FOR OTHER APPS FOR ELEMENTARY STUDENTS**

### **Login to Chromebook**

Chromebook Login is your child's email without the @sdoj.org portion. The Chromebook may be a touch screen or you can use the mouse pad. Again, **do not need to type in the @sdoj.org.**

- Username: \_\_\_\_\_ (most children will know their login, otherwise be sure to ask the teacher and **do not add @sdoj.org**)
  - Password: **SDOJeff1** (case sensitive)
  - **Launching Clever** (Clever is our school's digital learning platform that uses a single sign-on to find apps, resources, communication, and instruction.)
    - Clever should automatically launch, if it doesn't click on the Clever Tab on the toolbar.
    - Click on "**Log in with Google**" to take you to the Main Page to see all of the Apps
    - There are numerous applications on the main Clever page. Google Meet, Seesaw, Dreambox, Lexia apps and more are found on this page.
    - Teachers may also have an app on the main Clever page. Through the teacher page, you will find the main apps that your teacher wants you to use
- **Join a Google Meet** (Google meet is used as a real-time meeting between teachers and students)
- Click on the Google Meet app on Main Clever page
  - Click the "Use a meeting code"
  - Type in (**THE CODE YOUR TEACHER GIVES YOU**) and hit continue
  - The code may be the same or different for each meet, be sure to follow exactly what your teacher gives you for the code. If you have followed the code exactly you should be asked to click "join now". If this does not work, recheck both your code and your schedule.
- **Seesaw** (Seesaw is a classroom app used to keep students engaged and connected in distance learning settings)
- Click on the app on Main Clever page. If it tells you that "a google account exists" click OK
  - Click "I am a student"
  - **DO NOT type in your email and password**
  - Click "Sign in With Google" at the top

- It will prompt you to Choose an account: Click on your name
- Click on the “Activities/Light Bulb” to see assigned content
- You will see a red oval with a number in the middle. This is how many assignments you need to complete.
- To switch to a different teacher: reading/music/phy ed/art/guidance etc, click on your name in the upper left corner. The different classes to choose from will drop down. Again, you will see a red oval, this has how many assignments you need to complete in all classes.

→ **Lexia** (Lexia reading is a computerized reading program that provides phonics instruction and gives students independent practice in basic reading skills. **Lexia** Reading is designed to help teachers provide student-driven and teacher-directed personalized instruction.)

- Click on Lexia Core5 on main Clever page
- Click arrow
- Begin lesson assigned

→ **Dreambox** (Dreambox is a K-8 digital math program used to provide rigorous and interactive lessons which adapt to each student providing a personalized learning experience.)

- Select the Dreambox app on main Clever page
- Choose the next lesson to be completed

→ **Other apps:** There are multiple other apps available to use on the Clever page. All of these will be explained in more detail by the individual teacher - and codes, logins, and passwords will be provided for apps in which the student is assigned to use.
