

# HOME HEALTH SCREEN 2020-2021

Jefferson County Health Dept. Guidelines as of 8/20/2020

**If you (the student) respond "yes" to any of these questions, please DO NOT come to school or send your child to school.**

- Within the past 14 days, have you been around anyone who tested positive for Coronavirus or is presumed to be positive?
- Within the past 14 days, have you traveled out of the state to a known hot spot?

**If yes, YOU MUST NOTIFY YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL OR SCHOOL PRINCIPAL.** Traveling to known hot spot locations (out of state or internationally) require a 14-day quarantine if your travel is determined to be high risk.
- Are you currently taking any medication to treat or reduce fever such as ibuprofen (i.e. Advil, Motrin) or Acetaminophen (Tylenol)?

**Are you (the student) currently experiencing any of the following?**

## Any ONE of these symptoms

- Cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- Fever of 100.4 or higher
- Nausea/vomiting
- Diarrhea

## Any TWO of these symptoms

- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose

## Stay at home if you (the student)



Have one or more symptoms in box 1



Have two or more symptoms in box two



Are taking fever reduction medicine

Using the table above, upon showing symptoms of COVID-19 listed, **shift to virtual instruction for 3 days. If symptoms remain persistent for 3 days, or if symptoms worsen, shift to virtual instruction for 10 days.**

**If your child stayed home as a result of answering "yes" to any of the above questions, we ask that you call your school office prior to returning your child to school.**

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
