

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

The Board has a responsibility for maintaining a minimum program of instruction guaranteed by the state statutes and for initiating improvements beyond that minimum.

Instructional staff, under the direction and supervision of the Director of Curriculum and Instruction, shall be delegated the responsibility for proposing and developing curriculum changes and additions. Communication and coordination among grade level and subject area teachers should be emphasized on a kindergarten through grade 12 basis whenever curriculum is developed.

The district's curriculum and instructional programs shall be planned in line with the state academic standards adopted by the Board of Education.

All subject area offerings and any additions or deletions to the curriculum shall be reviewed and adopted by the Board before they are initiated or dropped from the existing program of instruction.
