

GRADING SYSTEMS

The district shall evaluate student achievement in grades K-4 through 12 through the issuance of progress reports on a regular basis. This serves to:

1. promote a process of continuous evaluation of student achievement;
2. inform the student and his/her parent(s)/guardian(s) of the student's achievement and growth over time; and
3. provide a basis for bringing about change in student achievement, if such change is deemed necessary.

The School District of Jefferson shall not discriminate in the methods, practices, and materials used for evaluating students on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
