

SHARED PROGRAMMING

Courses

Students enrolled in a private school or home-based private educational program may take courses at the high school in accordance with state law.

Federally Funded Programs

The School District of Jefferson participates in various programs, projects and grants funded by federal sources. The Superintendent, or designee, shall ensure that resident students who are enrolled in private schools have an opportunity to participate in federally funded programs in accordance with federal law.

District Testing Programs

Current home-based students, who live within the district, may, upon written request, participate in the district's achievement testing program. Testing is to occur at school at the same time as the student's peer group is tested. It is the parent's/guardian's responsibility to request test dates and places from the principal and to provide transportation for the testing.
