

STUDENT DRESS AND GROOMING CODE

Students are expected to dress and groom in a manner that:

1. is clean and safe;
2. does not endanger the health or welfare of the wearer or others;
3. does not disrupt or distract from the instructional process of the school.

Footwear must be worn at all times. Garments specifically designed for outdoor wear may be worn in classrooms only with authorization from school officials.

In cases when a teacher judges a student's dress or grooming is hazardous to the safety, health, or welfare of a student in regard to safety and maintenance requirements evident in the nature of his/her course, the judgement of the teacher shall stand. The teacher is authorized to require necessary utility clothing such as hats, aprons, coveralls, specific types of footwear and swimming caps or hairnets.
