

USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS

The use of tobacco products is prohibited while on premises owned by, rented by or under the control of the Board; on school-sponsored transportation; or participating in a school-sponsored event. Possession of tobacco products by students under the age of 18 is illegal and strictly prohibited.

For the purposes of this policy, "tobacco products" refer to lighted, smoking tobacco, smokeless tobacco, or smokeless nicotine delivery devices.

For purposes of this policy, "school-sponsored transportation" means any automobile, bus, train, airplane, boat or ship, whether owned or leased by the district or not, in or upon which district employees, students and/or guests or chaperones are transported to any destination as part of any activity conducted by, authorized by or carried on with the approval of the district.

Persons using tobacco products in violation of this policy shall be dealt with in accordance with established procedures.
